

RBI Kehta Hai Know your banknotes



The new ₹ 10 denomination banknotes in the **Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series** bear signature of the Governor, Reserve Bank of India. The note has motif of 'Sun Temple, Konark' on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage. The base colour of the note is chocolate brown.

The note has other designs and geometric patterns aligning with the overall colour scheme, both at obverse and reverse

The size of the new note is 63 mm X 123 mm

Features of the New ₹ 10 Notes

Obverse:

- 1 See through register in denominational numeral 10
- 2 Denominational numeral ₹ in Devnagari
- 3 Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
- 4 Micro letters 'Bharat' and 'India'
- 5 Windowed demetalised security thread with inscriptions 'Bharat' and 'RBI'
- 6 Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right of Mahatma Gandhi's portrait
- 7 Mahatma Gandhi's portrait and electrotype (10) watermarks
- 8 Number panel with numerals in ascending font on the top left side and bottom right side
- 9 Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right

Reverse:

- 10 Year of printing of the note on the left
- 11 Swachh Bharat logo with slogan
- 12 Language panel
- 13 Motif of Sun Temple, Konark
- 14 Denominational numeral ₹ in Devnagari
