The new ₹20 denomination banknotes in the **Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series** bear signature of the Governor, Reserve Bank of India. The note has motif of Ellora Caves on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage. The base colour of the note is Greenish Yellow. The note has other designs, geometric patterns aligning with the overall colour scheme, both at the

obverse and reverse.

The size of the new note is 63 mm X 129 mm

- See through register with denominational numeral 20
- 2 Denominational numeral so in Devnagari
- Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
- 4 Micro letters 'भारत', 'INDIA'
- 5 Windowed demetalised security thread with inscriptions 'भारत' and RBI
- 6 Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right of Mahatma Gandhi portrait

- 7 Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right
 8 Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype (20) watermarks
- Number panel with numerals in ascending font on the top left side and bottom right side.

- 10 Year of printing of the note on the left
- Swachh Bharat logo with slogan
- 12 Language panel
- 13 Motif of Ellora Caves
- 14 Denominational numeral २० in Devnagari.
