


## मुद्रास्फीति पर घरेलू अपेक्षाओं का सर्वेक्षण

आज, रिज़र्व बैंक ने अपने द्विमासिक मुद्रास्फीति पर घरेलू अपेक्षाओं का सर्वेक्षण (आईईएसएच)<sup>1,2</sup> के जनवरी 2026 दौर के परिणाम जारी किए। यह सर्वेक्षण 2-11 जनवरी 2026 के दौरान 19 प्रमुख शहरों में आयोजित किया गया था, जिसमें 6,079 प्रतिक्रियाएं प्राप्त हुईं।

### मुख्य विशेषताएँ:

- वर्तमान औसत मुद्रास्फीति के बारे में परिवारों की धारणा पिछले दौर की तुलना में 30 आधार अंक (बीपीएस) बढ़कर 6.9 प्रतिशत हो गई। इसके साथ ही, तीन महीनों और एक साल आगे के लिए उनकी मुद्रास्फीति की अपेक्षाएं क्रमशः 30 बीपीएस और 60 बीपीएस बढ़कर 7.9 प्रतिशत और 8.6 प्रतिशत हो गईं [चार्ट 1ए और 1बी; टेबल 3]।
- अल्पकालिक और एक वर्ष आगे, दोनों अवधियों के लिए, सामान्य कीमतों और मुद्रास्फीति में वृद्धि की अपेक्षा करने वाले उत्तरदाताओं की हिस्सेदारी में वृद्धि हुई, जिससे उनकी गिरावट की प्रवृत्ति में बदलाव आया [टेबल 1(ए) और 1(बी)]।
- परिवारों ने दोनों समयावधियों के लिए के लिए सभी उत्पाद समूहों में मूल्य और मुद्रास्फीति के दबाव की अपेक्षाओं की सूचना दी [टेबल 1(ए) और 1(बी)]।

<sup>1</sup> यह सर्वेक्षण रिज़र्व बैंक द्वारा द्विमासिक अंतराल पर आयोजित किया जाता है; यह उत्तरदाताओं की अपेक्षाओं के अनुसार निकट भविष्य में मुद्रास्फीति के दबावों पर दिशात्मक जानकारी प्रदान करता है और उनके अपने उपभोग पैटर्न को भी प्रतिबिंबित कर सकता है। इसलिए, सर्वेक्षण के परिणाम उत्तरदाताओं के विचारों को दर्शाते हैं, जिनसे रिज़र्व बैंक सहमत नहीं होता।
